"Since the close of the public comment period on June 4, the CALT has reviewed the public comment and feedback from listening sessions. The team has continued to refine the draft climate policy, adding an additional policy statement on education and workforce development.

As the team reviews public comment on the draft climate policy, it is also working with state agency representatives, the Science Advisory Panel, and the Oil and Gas Technical Advisory Panel to develop the second part of the climate strategy, a recommended climate action plan. This plan consists of **over 50 specific actions that the State can take in its response to climate change in the areas of**

bombarding the Yemeni port city of Hodeidah. In a country already suffering greatly from this prolonged war, this attack on Yemen's main port is preventing vital humanitarian aid supplies from getting to those who desperately need them.

At least 15,000 civilians have already been killed in the war. Up to a million Yemenis have been affected by cholera. The UN reports that 10.6 million Yemenis are on the verge of starvation. At least 22 million Yemenis—80% of the country's population—rely on the aid that comes through Hodeidah. Prior to the in-person meeting on August 2, the CALT will hold a Young Leaders Dialogue on Climate Change at the Dena'ina Center in Anchorage. Over the course of the day, participants will hear from the CALT and invited speakers, engage in small group discussions, and work toward a statement of action that builds from the draft state climate strategy. The CALT is currently accepting nominations for participants...until July 12...
